POSITIONING & MANAGEMENT

Driller Daikon Radish is an excellent choice to plant as a catch crop following corn or soybeans. Because of its unique plant characteristics, it provides the following benefits:

- Quick to establish and generates large amounts of biomass above and below ground
- Will winterkill at temperatures in the low 20's, leaving decaying top growth to shield soil from erosion and shade out early annual weeds
- Taproot can reach depths of 30 inches catching nitrogen (N) and other nutrients
- Decaying radishes increase microbial activity, enrich organic matter and improve water infiltration and holding capacity
- Mixes well with Cereal Rye and FIXatioN Balansa Clover



PLANTING RECOMMENDATIONS

- **Timing:** July 1 to Sept. 30 based on zone
- **Rate:** For monoculture stands: 8-10 lbs/acre broadcast, 6 lbs/acre drilled. In mixes: 4-6 lbs/acre broadcast and 2-3 lbs/acre drilled
- **Depth:** 1/4" to 1/2" deep or broadcast
- **Soils:** Prefers well-drained soils with a pH range 6.4 to 7.3
