



## **POSITIONING & MANAGEMENT**

Balansa Clover is a cool-season annual legume highly adapted to a variety of soil conditions. It's quick to germinate and provides a variety of benefits:

- Revives soil by unlocking nutrients from deeper depths and improving soil health
- Can fix more than 100 lbs N/acre
- Deep taproot creates channels for air, water and subsequent roots
- Survives short-term flooding and challenging soils
- Provides abundant forage up to 5,250 pounds of dry matter/acre in a single cutting
- Crude protein from 22% to 28% and relative feed values as high as 277
- Excellent option for interseeding in established alfalfa fields or mixed with cereal rye

## **PLANTING RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Timing: Up to July 1 through Sept. 30 based on zone
- Rate: 3-5 lbs/a in a mix, 5-8 lbs/a in a monoculture
- Depth: Drill 1/8" to 1/4" deep or broadcast
- **Soils:** Adaptable to a variety of soils; will tolerate moderate salinty and pH from 4.5 to 8
