

L 1494 E3**1.4 RM****POSITIONING & MANAGEMENT**

Terrific appearance, great emergence and standability are just a few highlights of this 1.4 soybean. It does not carry a Phytophthora gene but does offer complete resistance to Brown Stem Rot as well as a good rating for White Mold. SCN tolerance is from PI 88788.
